Assam Governor inaugurates 132nd conference of All India Brahmo Samaj Pays rich tributes to Raja Ram Mohan Roy; hails the efforts of Samaj to removing social evils

Guwahati, December 27: Assam Governor Shri Gulab Chand Kataria inaugurated the 132nd Conference of All India Brahmo Samaj held at South Point School in the city today.

He made incomparable contributions in the field of education and the revival of the society and rediscover its innate vitality. The Indian society will always be grateful to him for his contribution to social welfare.

Governor Shri Kataria also said that Brahmo Samaj was not just a concept, it was the most powerful socio-cultural movement in the county which paved the way for large-scale social reformation. Brahmo Samaj put the importance of Upanishads and Vedas before everyone, which also raised voice for farmers, laborers and workers' interests.

Shri Kataria said that due to the superstition, women were burnt alive. The main inspiration behind the establishment of Brahmo Samaj was the practice of Sati prevalent at that time, the Governor added. He also said that illiteracy was one of the primary causes of social evils. Therefore the principles of Brahmo Samaj include knowledge, free will and truthfulness, the Governor observed.

The Governor expressed happiness to learn that the Gauhati Brahmo Samaj is working for the uplift of the society and also making an important contribution to the spiritual, cultural and literary development of the society.
